Junior Squash

Junior Squash will be starting up again in January 2013. John Dewis, the club champion and ESR registered squash coach will be taking the sessions. Please look out for further updates on the website. To register your interest please email enquiries@stivo-squash.co.uk.

Coaching and Training

Group sessions have been arranged, using coaches from within the Club and external qualified coaches to provide support to team players, upper and lower box league players, ladies and social players. These sessions are either free or priced to cover the court costs only.

The Club also sponsors members who wish to become Level 1- Assistant Coaches or Level 2 - Club Coaches.

Box Leagues

Singles leagues for members run with the year divided into winter leagues (October to March) and summer leagues (April to September). Only players who have paid their membership are eligible to play in the leagues. Monthly leagues are sent to all members by email. It is the responsibility of players to arrange their matches with fellow league members.

Members who achieve 30 points, 60 points and 90 points receive a free off peak court voucher.

There is also a Racketball ladder in operation.

Tournaments

We hold a range of members-only events for all abilities such as the Turkey and Beastie (both graded events), Men's and Ladies Club Championships and a Team Tournament.

Racketball tournaments are also held, including a very popular and nationally recognised "Open".

Senior Teams

There is a Men's team and Ladies team which play in the Cambridgeshire Leagues during the winter season and there is a Men's team in the Peterborough summer League. Men's Club Captain is Alistair Paul and Ladies Team Manager is Jayne Gostelow. Both are always pleased to talk to players who would like to find out more about team squash.

Squash Club Nights

Each Monday evening at 7:40 from September to April – play games at all levels.

Racketball Club Night

Every Thursday evening from 7:30 throughout the year, you can join in and experience the subtle differences of racketball. There are details on the notice board outside the courts.

What happens to your membership money?

We pay annual subscriptions for all paid up members to England Squash & Racketball; this helps to run the national governing body and support the network of the County squash organisation – some of the money filters back to Cambridgeshire each year. England Squash & Racketball are very supportive of St Ivo. We have worked with them to gain grant money for new equipment and a new heating system for the courts.

The club also pays for affiliation to Cambridgeshire SRA, insurance, buys squash and racketball equipment including balls and safety wear for juniors and coaching purposes, provides coaching, supports players who wish to train to be coaches or have been selected to play at a high level, and supports social and tournament activity.

The club also pay court costs to One Leisure for organised club events such as club nights, and provides a liaison point for members with One Leisure.
